| 0 | July 9 Wednesday | Depart for Israel | In flight |
| 1 | July 10 Thursday | Arrive in Tel Aviv in the morning. Please choose flights that arrive before 11 am in order to join the afternoon of touring enroute to your hotel. Head north along the Mediterranean coast. Stop at Israel College of the Bible and the ONE FOR ISRAEL media studios. Hear the testimonies of Jewish and Arab staff members. Visit Caesarea, Herod's magnificent port city, where the centurion Cornelius heard the good news (Acts 10) and Paul g.ave his defense before Roman rulers and King Agrippa II (Acts 24 and 26). | Haifa, Nof Hotel or similar |



| 2 | July 11 Friday | Travel to the northern border with Lebanon to Tel Dan , one of the two alternative sites of worship built by King Jeroboam. Tour Caesarea Philippi (Matt 16:13ff) and then ascend the Golan Heights for a view into Syria from Mt. Bental. | Haifa, Nof Hotel or similar |

| 3 | July 12 Saturday | Attend a Messianic worship service in Karmiel. Tour the archaeological ruins of the ancient town of Megiddo , a key city which Solomon fortified. Ascend Mt. Carmel to remember the contest between Elijah and the prophets of Baal. Return to Haifa via the Druze Village of Daliat el-Carmel. | Haifa Nof Hotel or similar |
| 4 | July 13 Sunday | Visit the Messianic retirement home, Ebenezer. Spend the rest of the day around the Sea of Galilee . Sail on its waters and enjoy a fish lunch together (included). In the afternoon, visit Capernaum , the town that became Yeshua's ministry base, and the Mount of Beatitudes (Matthew 5,6 and 7). Visit other sites connected with the ministry of Yeshua, as time permits. | Haifa Nof Hotel or similar |
| 5 | July 14 Monday | Travel south to along the Jordan Valley to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. Explore Herod's spectacular mountain fortress, Masada. There will be an opportunity to float in the Dead Sea. Continue south to the Red Sea port of Eilat, Free evening to walk along the boardwalk. | Eilat. Nova Hotel or similar |
| 6 | July 15 Tuesday | There will be an early morning sunrise hike (optional) . In the morning visit Timna Park, including the Model of the Tabernacle. Return to Eilat and spend the afternoon either visiting the Underwater Observatory , or snorkling on the Coral Beach . | Eilat, Nova Hotel or similar |

| 7 | July 16 Wednesday | Leaving Eilat, stop on the "Moses Route" to remember the wilderness wanderings. Visit communities on the border with Gaza, including the memorial to those killed at the Nova music festival. Then UP TO JERUSALEM! | Jerusalem, Prima Kings Hotel or similar |
| 8 | July 17 Thursday | Tour the excavations around the Southern Steps of Temple Mount and learn about pilgrimage to Jerusalem at the time of Jesus. Visit the City of David , including Hezekiah's water tunnel [or the (dry) Canaanite Tunnel], and the Pool of Siloam . Tour the Western Wall Tunnels , the underground excavations along the side of Temple Mount. | Jerusalem, Prima Kings Hotel or similar |
| 9 | July 18 Friday | Enjoy a panoramic view over the Old City from the Mount of Olives and walk down the hill to the Garden of Gethsemane . There will be a walking tour of the Old City , including the Pools of Bethesda (and St. Anne's church with its amazing acoustics), and the Church of the Holy Sepulcher . In the afternoon visit the Jewish Quarter and stop at the tradition site for remembering the Upper Room . Enjoy free time in the Old City . | Jerusalem Prima Kings Hotel or similar |
| 10 | July 19 Saturday | Begin the day with a tour of the Garden Tomb , where the group can share the Lord's Supper together. Attend worship service at a local Messianic congregation led by Meno Kalisher. In the afternoon, tour the Israel Museum , including the Shrine of the Book , with its Dead Sea Scrolls exhibit, and | Jerusalem, Prima Kings Hotel or similar |

- Ten nights' accommodation in a shared room for two people (additional payment for those requesting a room by themselves).
- Israeli breakfast and dinner daily.
- One included lunch, as per itinerary (a fish lunch on the Sea of Galilee)
- Ten touring days with a professional and licensed English-speaking guide
- Air-conditioned luxury tourist bus as per program
- ▶ Entrance fees to sites mentioned in the itinerary
- Luggage loaders at hotels

BOOKINGS AND RATES

- o If a roommate cannot be assigned or is not wanted, single-room rates will apply.
- Registration closes April 9, 2025
- A non-refundable deposit of \$300 per person is required at the time of registration.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION PENALTIES

- **Final Payment** should be made by April 9, 2025
- 25% of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel 90-61 days before the tour
- 50 % of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel 60-31 days before the tour
- 100 % of total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs 30-0 days before the tour

DOCUMENTS
