ITINERARY

DAY	DATE	PROGRAM	OVERNIGHT
0	March 29 (Saturday)	Depart USA	In flight
1	March 30 (Sunday)	Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport. Meet your guide and driver. Travel to your hotel in Samaria for a good night's rest.	Ariel, Eshel Hashomron or similar
2	March 31 (Monday)	Visit Tel Shiloh , where the tabernacle once stood and the boy Samuel served as a helper to Ely the high priest. Continue to Mt. Gerizim , the mountain of blessing, and site of the Samaritan Temple. Visit either Mt. Ebal or Bethel, (depending on IDF permissions on the day of the tour).	Ariel, Eshel Hashomron or similar
3	April 1 (Tuesday)	Stop at Israel College of the Bible , for a brief introduction to what God is doing in the Land through media outreach and education. Tour Caesarea Maritima , where the centurion Cornelius heard the gospel and Paul stood trial before governors Felix and Festus (Acts 24 and 26). Continue to Mt. Carmel , a symbol of beauty in biblical poetry, where Elijah called for a contest with the prophets of Baal and Asherah. Visit Nazareth , including a tour of Nazareth Village , a reenactment of life in a first century AD Galilean village. End the day at your hotel by the Sea of Galilee.	Sea of Galilee, Ohalo Mansions or similar
4	April 2 (Wednesday)	At Tel Dan enjoy a pleasant stroll along the stream to the ancient temple where the Jeroboam I set up one of the Golden Calves (1 Kings 12). Hike the region of Caesarea Philippi (Matt 16:13). Enjoy a fish lunch together near the Sea of Galilee (included). Tour Capernaum (Yeshua's ministry base) followed by a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee . Stop at the remains of a 2000 year old fishing boat, nicknamed the " Jesus Boat ".	Sea of Galilee, Ohalo Mansions or similar

5	April 3 (Thursday)	Visit the vicinity of the biblical city of Jezreel , Ahab's chariot center. Stop at the nearby Spring of Harod , where Gideon tested his men (Judges 7). Follow the Jordan River south to the area in which Jesus was baptized (Qasr el-Yahud). In this area was Gilgal – the first encampment of the Israelites after they crossed into the Promised land. Enter Jericho to tour the ancient mound and visit the spring. You'll pass a grand old Sycamore tree to visualize Zaccheus, longing to see Jesus. Stop in the Wilderness of Judea backdrop to the story of the Good Samaritan and site of the temptation of Jesus.	Dead Sea, Kalia Guest house, or similar
6	April 4 (Friday)	Hike at En Gedi , where David hid from Saul (I Sam 24). Continue to Beer Sheba , one of the sites where Abraham sojourned. Turning north to the Judean Shephelah, stop at the Valley of Elah , site of the battle between David and Goliath, and at Gath of the Philistines , hometown of Goliath. Then, up to Jerusalem!	Jerusalem, Prima Kings or similar
7	April 5 (Saturday)	Visit the neighborhood of greater Jerusalem on the east side of the Mount of Olives, where the village of Bethany was located in the time of Jesus. Stop at the traditional tomb of Lazarus . Enjoy a panoramic view over Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives. Visit the Garden of Gethsemane, in the Kidron Valley. Other New Testament events also took place in this area, such as the stoning of Stephen and the death of James (the leader of the early believers in Jerusalem). Visit the " Upper Room ", " Caiaphas's house " and the Garden Tomb . Continue to Hebron. Here Abraham bought a cave to bury his beloved wife. End the day in Bethlehem .	Jerusalem, Prima Kings or similar
8	April 6 (Sunday)	Ascend Temple Mount , once site of the Biblical temple and now home to the "Noble Sanctuary", including the El-Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. Tour the City of David , including Hezekiah's water tunnel (optional), and the Pool of Siloam . There will be an Old City walking tour including the Western Wall and the Church of the Holy Sepulcher . Depending on the time of your flights the rest of the afternoon is free for browsing the colorful Old City bazaars. Visit Jaffa (New Testament Joppa) to remember Peter's vision on the roof of Simon the Tanner's house (Acts 10) and Jonah's sea voyage. Enjoy a farewell dinner before transferring to the airport for flights home.	No hotel included this night

- Lunches (except the fish lunch on day 4)
- Sodas and alcohol at the hotels
- All expenses of a personal nature

BOOKINGS AND RATES

- The price for this tour is based on 20 paying participants.
- Changes can occur in hotels. Changes in price may also be necessary, due to exchange rate fluctuations, up to 60 days before departure.
- If a roommate cannot be assigned or is not wanted, single-room rates will apply.

- Registration closes December 22, 2024 (or earlier, if the tour is full).
- A non-refundable deposit of **\$300 per person**, paid online to Israel College of the Bible is required to secure registration. You will be directed to the payment site at the end of registration.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION PENALTIES

- **Final Payment** should be made by December 29, 2024
- 25% of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after Dec 29, 2024
- 50 % of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after Jan 29, 2025.
- 100 % of total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs after Feb 28, 2025.

TRAVEL AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

We strongly advise you to purchase **travel cancellation insurance** for your trip to Israel, to cover both your flight ticket and your land package. **Cancellation insurance** covers your expenses in case of cancellation due to unforeseen health and other issues (depending on the type of policy purchased).
