1	March 9 (Sunday)	Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport and transfer to our hotel in Netanya.	Netanya, Residence Hotel (or similar)
2	March 10 (Monday)	Attend an Introductory Lecture at the Israel College of the Bible: Overview of the Geography of the Land of the Bible. Tour Caesarea Maritima , where the centurion Cornelius heard the gospel and Paul stood trial before governors Felix and Festus (Acts 24 and 26). Continue to Mt. Carmel , symbol of beauty in biblical poetry, where Elijah called a contest with the prophets of Baal and Asherah. Continue to Nazareth , Yeshua's boyhood home, with a panoramic view over the Jezreel Valley. Evening Lecture : The Geography of the Conquest and Judges.	Nazareth – Tabar Hotel (or similar)
3	March 11 (Tuesday)	Visit Nazareth Village, a reenactment of life in first century Nazareth. Travel to Megiddo, on the western fringe of the Jezreel Valley, and discuss its important roll throughout the biblical period and its suggested connection with New Testament Armageddon. Continue to Tel Jezreel, site of Ahab and Jezebel's summer palace (I Kings 21), and Gideon's Spring (Judges 7), where he tested his men. At the end of the day relax overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Evening Lecture: The United and Divided Monarchies	Sea of Galilee, Ohalo Guest House or similar
4	March 12 Wednesday	Tour Tel Hazor , the northern Canaanite town that headed the opposition to Joshua (Joshua 11). At Tel Dan enjoy a pleasant stroll along the stream to the ancient temple where the Jeroboam I set up one of the Golden Calves (1 Kings 12). Hike the region of Caesarea Philippi (Matt 16:13). Evening Lecture : <i>Geography of the Gospels</i> .	Sea of Galilee, Ohalo Guest House or similar





5	March 13 (Thursday)	Today we spend the day around the beautiful Sea of Galilee, focusing on the geography of Jesus' ministry. Visit Kursi and discuss the possible locations of the casting out of demons from the man who dwelt among the tombs. Tour Capernaum (Yeshua's ministry base) and Magdala (home of Mary Magdalene). Visit the traditional Mt. of Beatitudes and Peter's Fishing Place at Tabgha. Evening Lecture: Geography of the Second Temple Period.	Sea of Galilee, Ohalo Guest House or similar
6	March 14 (Friday)	Follow the Jordan River to the area near Jericho where Yeshua was baptized by John. Tour Qumran, near the caves in which the Dead Sea Scrolls were found, followed by the opportunity to float in the Dead Sea. Stop in the Judean Wilderness to remember the temptation of Yeshua, and the setting for his parable of the Good Samaritan. Then UP TO JERUSALEM! Enjoy a panoramic view over the city from the Mount of Olives. Visit the traditional Garden of Gethsemane. Welcome in the Sabbath together. Evening Lecture: Jerusalem in the Second Temple Period	Jerusalem, Ibis City Center (or similar)
7	March 14 Saturday	Take a walking tour through the Old City, stopping at the Pools of Bethesda (John 5), the Church of the Holy Sepulcher and the Garden Tomb. Visit Herodion (Herod the Great's palace and burial place), and a shepherd's cave near Bethlehem. There will be some free time for browsing the Old City markets, walking on the Old City walls, or other personal activities. No lecture this evening.	Jerusalem, Ibis City Center (or similar)

- ▶ Seven nights' accommodation in double rooms (a shared room for 2 people there is an additional payment required for those requesting a room of their own).
- ▶ Israeli breakfast and dinner daily (except for dinner on the day of departure)
- ▶ Seven touring days with a professional and licensed English-speaking guide
- ▶ Five optional evening lectures
- ▶ Air-conditioned tourist bus as per program
- ▶ Entrance fees to sites mentioned in the itinerary

BOOKINGS AND RATES

- ▶ This tour is still gathering the minimum 15 participants needed for it to be "guaranteed departure".
- ▶ Changes can occur in hotels due to factors beyond our control. Changes in price may also be necessary, due to exchange rate fluctuations, up to 60 days before departure.
- ▶ If a roommate cannot be assigned or is not wanted, single-room rates will apply.

- A non-refundable deposit of **\$300 per person**, paid online to Israel College of the Bible is required to secure registration. You will be directed to the payment site at the end of registration.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION PENALTIES

- Final Payment should be made by December 9, 2024
- 25% of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel 90-61 days before departure
- 50 % of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel 60-31 days before departure
- 100 % of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel 30-0 days before departure
